




Industry Snapshot

- Professional filmmakers living and working in the NWT are often multi-skilled and able to fill a variety of production roles, both as entrepreneurs who initiate new projects and as service providers and contractors.



How does the Northwest Territories Film Commission support commercial film and media in the NWT?


