DRAFT Terms of Reference for the Special Committee on Healthcare Management

1. Purpose

The Special Committee on Healthcare Management (the "Committee") is established by the Legislative Assembly of the Northwest Territories (NWT) to provide oversight of the Public Administrator appointed by the Honourable Minister of Health and Social Services to manage the Northwest Territories Health and Social Services Authority (NTHSSA). The Committee will monitor the performance and decisions of the Public Administrator and assess their impact on the delivery of health and social services in the territory.

2. Mandate

The Committee's mandate is to:

- 1. Provide legislative oversight of the Public Administrator's management of the NTHSSA.
- 2. Review the Public Administrator's decisions, priorities, and policies related to healthcare and social services delivery.
- 3. Assess the effectiveness and efficiency of the Public Administrator's governance of the NTHSSA.
- 4. Monitor the Public Administrator's engagement with Indigenous governments, community leaders, healthcare providers, and residents.
- 5. Examine the financial management and accountability of the NTHSSA under the Public Administrator's leadership.
- 6. Identify any risks or challenges related to the governance model of the NTHSSA.
- 7. Make recommendations to the Legislative Assembly on any required policy or legislative changes to improve governance and oversight of health and social services in the NWT.

3. Membership

The Committee shall consist of:

Members of the Legislative Assembly, one of whom will be of the Executive Council; the Chair and Deputy Chair will be elected by the Committee members; and The Chair must not be a member of the Executive Council;

4. Responsibilities of the Committee

The Committee shall:

Conduct regular reviews of reports and updates provided by the Public Administrator.

Engage with stakeholders, including healthcare professionals, Indigenous governments, community organizations, and residents, to gather feedback on the Public Administrator's performance.

Hold regular meetings to discuss the progress and impact of the Public Administrator's management.

Prepare interim and final reports with recommendations for submission to the Legislative Assembly.

Ensure transparency and accountability in its operations, while maintaining confidentiality where required by law.

5. Reporting Requirements

The Committee shall:

- 1. Submit an interim report to the Legislative Assembly within six months of its establishment, outlining preliminary observations and recommendations.
- 2. Provide additional reports as required by the Legislative Assembly.
- 3. Submit a final report upon the conclusion of the Public Administrator's term.

6. Duration of the Committee

The Committee's mandate will be tied to the term of the Public Administrator appointed by the Minister of Health and Social Services. The Committee will automatically dissolve upon the conclusion of the Public Administrator's appointment, unless otherwise extended by the Legislative Assembly.

7. Resources and Support

The Committee will be provided with the necessary administrative, research, and legal support to fulfill its mandate. Funding for the Committee's operations will be allocated from the Legislative Assembly's budget.

8. Amendments to the Terms of Reference

These Terms of Reference may be amended by resolution of the Legislative Assembly.
