## **Practice of Using Power Limiting Devices in the Northwest Territories**

Under section 74(1) of the *Public Utilities Act*, any public utility operating in the Northwest Territories must provide any information requested by the Public Utilities Board. In light of the current practice of using power limiting devices by utilities and power distributors operating in the Northwest Territories, I submit the following questions to the Minister responsible for the Public Utilities Board:

1. What is the current number of power limiters installed in residential homes across the Northwest Territories by the Northwest Territories Power Corporation, broken down by region and by community;
2. What is the number of power limiters installed by the Northwest Territories Power Corporation since resumption of the use of limiters as announced in the press release of October 21, 2020;
3. What is the current number of power limiters installed in residential homes across the Northwest Territories by Northland Utilities (NWT) Limited (An ATCO Company), broken down by region and by community; and
4. What is the current number of power limiters installed in residential homes across the Northwest Territories by the Northland Utilities (Yellowknife) An ATCO and NII Company?
