#### **PREFACE**

On June 4, 2021 Monfwi MLA Jackson Lafferty vacated his seat which caused a by-election. On June 9, 2021 Ms. Margaret Thom, as the Commissioner of the Northwest Territories signed a Writ of Election Order directing Chief Electoral Officer Nicole Latour, to issue a Writ of election to the Returning Officer of Monfwi.

The Writ of Election, issued on June 28, 2021, set polling day for July 27, 2021 and the return of the Writ as August 10, 2021. Proclamations were posted in the communities of Behchoko, Gameti, Wekweeti and Whati on June 28, 2021 and nomination period commenced.

By the close of nominations on Friday July 2, 2021 at 2pm four candidates stood for election: Three men and one woman. By 5pm none of the candidates had withdrawn and the campaign activities continued, and ballots were print.

## Voting

In total, 935 ballots were cast in the 2021Monfwi by-election. This participation represents a 53 percent voter turnout; on par with, and only one percent lower than the 2019 Territorial General Election.

Prior to ordinary polling day, 9 percent of voters cast their ballots using a special voting opportunity. Electors had an option to vote in the office to the Returning Officer from July 5-24, make an application for an absentee ballot (mail-in) or mobile poll or attend an advance poll, July 20, 2021, in the communities of Gameti, Wekweeti and Whati.

The only ballots counted in the absentee poll were those of incarcerated persons.

To protect the secrecy of the ballot, the three small advance polls were reported as one number. The absentee poll, also small, was reported with the voting in the office of the returning officer again to provide secrecy of the ballot.

No Judicial Recount was required.


### Reporting

Upon the close of Ordinary Poll July 27, 2021, the unofficial results were reported to the public on the Elections NWT website. Official addition was completed on July 29, 2021.

The Return of the Writ of Election was returned to the Chief Electoral Officer July 29, 2021 bearing the name of the duly elected candidate, Jane Armstrong.






